Reliability on the road
to Carbon Neutrality





Uniper is an international energy company that operates over 22 GW of generation capacity in Europe, which ranks us among the world's largest power producers. We intend for our European power business to be 80% carbon neutral by 2030 and for the whole company to be carbon neutral by 2040.

To achieve our aim, we are transforming our existing assets and investing in low carbon, flexible, despatchable power generation, solar and wind power, as well as green gases such as hydrogen and biomethane.

In the UK, our portfolio of flexible and efficient power stations generates enough electricity to power around six million homes. Together with our fast-cycle gas storage facility, and our significant long-term regasification capacity to bring natural gas into the grid at the Grain LNG terminal in Kent, we are reliably supporting energy security today and ready to transform operations to secure a decarbonised economy tomorrow.

We also provide dedicated grid stability services and voltage control to the British electricity system operator National Grid ESO at our Killingholme and Grain Power Station sites. This is increasingly essential to help maintain grid stability and security of energy supplies, whilst enabling more solar and wind power to come onto the grid.

We are looking towards the future, and our aim is for our European power generation to be 80% carbon neutral by 2030. We are exploring a range of options to decarbonise our gas power stations, such as using technology to capture the carbon emitted, or converting power stations to run on low carbon fuels such as hydrogen or biofuels. In addition, Uniper plans to invest in hydrogen production facilities in the UK, and is exploring opportunities to develop onshore wind and solar projects at sites across the UK.






